

Dorian Block is the Project Manager of the Age-friendly New York City initiative. Age-friendly NYC aims to engage all public and private sectors of the city to become more inclusive of older adults. The initiative is staffed by The New York Academy of Medicine (NYAM) in partnership with the Mayor's Office and the New York City Council.

In her role, Dorian has led the creation of neighborhood-level Aging Improvement Districts in New York, worked with city agencies to integrate the concept into their agenda and advised cities around world launching their own age-friendly initiatives.

Dorian joined NYAM nearly three years ago, following seven years of work as an award-winning journalist at The New York Daily News, The Boston Globe and other publications. She holds an M.S. degree with honors from Columbia University's Graduate School of Journalism, where she was a fellow at the Stabile Center for Investigative Journalism.
